#### **ANTI-CORRUPTION (INTEGRITY)**

Do not pay or accept bribes of any sort even if they would benefit your business, your personal income or your status				
Any money borrowed or given to help my business may only ever be used for that purpose, unless a change of use is first agreed with the person who has provided the money				
Keep personal and business expenses separate. Pay yourself a salary – when you can afford to and keep records. Don't take or borrow money from your business
